

## Scenario 1: Small Network - Peer-to-Peer



(1) Computer RUNNING TC Command with FileMaker Pro 11 License in multi-user mode - Active

In this situation, this computer is acting as a small server, hosting TC Command for itself and other clients.

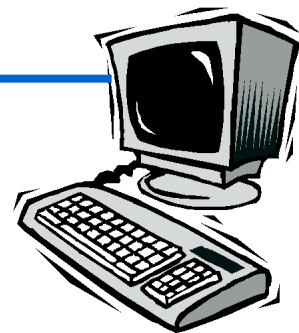
Drawbacks are that the program must be RUNNING at all times, if the primary computer were to QUIT or SHUTDOWN/Crash, the files will shut down. If the primary computer were to close the program, all others would be kicked off.

This scenario best for 2-4 computers, rarely accessing the files simultaneously or for long durations from the client computers.
