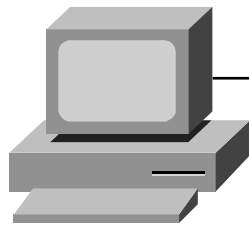


Small Office Network : Peer-to-Peer, Local Host



Primary PC (1)

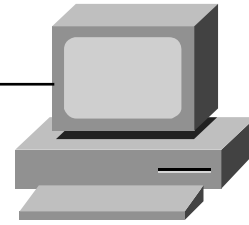
(Acts both as HOST & Client when program is up and running - can be minimized)

In this scenario a Primary PC is on and running the TC Command Software in Network Mode, acting as both TCP/IP Host and as one of the clients.

Drawbacks:

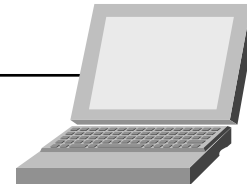
1. The program must be running at all times on the primary PC for any clients to access the data.
2. If the primary PC were to suddenly QUIT or SHUTDOWN/CRASH, the files will be abruptly closed and **possibly damaged**.
3. If the primary PC is off, no other client can access the data.

This scenario is best for 2-4 computers, accessing the files simultaneously but on a limited basis. Useful to extend the capability of a single user to support staff while all in the office.

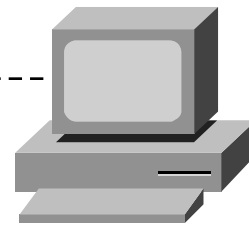


Client PC (2)
